### Class 1 - Leading Rein

1'3" (Approx. 35cms) *Rosettes to placings & Medal to the winner.*

### Class 2 - Open

1'6" (Approx. 45cms) May be Led.

*Rosettes to placings & Medal to the winner*

### Class 3 - Open

1'9" (Approx. 55cms) *Rosettes to placings & Medal to the winner.*

### Class 4 - Pairs Relay

2'0" (Approx. 60cms). A course of 12 fences; 1-6 to be jumped by first horse & rider and 7-12 to be jumped by second horse & rider. Fences 6 and 12 have a joker fence option, 5 seconds being deducted from the time if successfully jumped. Class to be judged on time, 4 seconds being added for every knock down.

### Class 5 - Open

2'3" (Approx. 70cms) *Rosettes to placings & Medal to the winner.*

### Class 6 - Open

2'6" (Approx. 75cms) *Rosettes to placings & Prizes 1st = £5,  
2nd = £4, 3rd = £3 (one prize money given for every five entries).*

### Class 7 - Open

2'9" (Approx. 85cms) *Rosettes to placings & Prizes 1st = £5,  
2nd = £4, 3rd = £3 (one prize money given for every five entries).*

### Class 8 - Open

3'0" (Approx. 90cms) *Rosettes to placings & Prizes 1st = £5,  
2nd = £4, 3rd = £3 (one prize money given for every five entries).*

### Ring 3 • Schooling Ring 10am Start • Running all day

Over a course of British Showjumping Fences, including a water tray. Height of fences can be altered.

£5 for 5 minutes • £10 for 10 minutes • £15 for 15 minutes

### Ring 4 • Clear Round Jumping • 10am Start • Running all day

Height of fences can be altered. £3 per round.

### Class 13 - Open

2'6" (Approx. 75cms). *Rosettes to placings & Prizes 1st = £5, 2nd = £4, 3rd = £3 (one prize money given for every five entries).*

### Class 14 - Open

2'9" (Approx. 85cms). *Rosettes to placings & Prizes 1st = £5, 2nd = £4, 3rd = £3 (one prize money given for every five entries).*

### Class 15 - Open

3'0" (Approx. 90cms). *Rosettes to placings & Prizes 1st = £5, 2nd = £4, 3rd = £3 (one prize money given for every five entries).*

### Class 16 - Open

3'3" (Approx. 1m). *Rosettes to placings & Prizes 1st = £5, 2nd = £4, 3rd = £3 (one prize money given for every five entries).*

### Class 19 - Best First Ridden Pony

Riders 12 years and under. Ponies not exceeding 13.2hh.

### Class 20 - Ridden Mountain and Moorland

Open to all heights and all ages. Small breeds can be led (leading rein to be attached to the noseband).

### Class 21 - Ridden Show Class

Open to all horses and ponies. To be judged on performance, manners and suitability.

### Class 22 - Veteran class

Open to all horses and ponies, 15 years and over.

### Class 23 - Ex-race Horse

Must have raced.

### Class 24 - Fancy Dress

Any height and any age. Hard hats must be worn.
